tribes within the larger group of tribes called the Brigantes. He described her as "flourishing in all the splendor of wealth and power ." This was Cartimandua (about 47-69 CE), whose name includes the word for "pony" or "small horse."

When the Romans arrived in Britain in 43 AD, they were culturally, a settled and stable society with a strong queen, Cartimandua. In it was in the interests of the Brigantes to work alongside the Romans. If an amicable

status quo could be achieved, then the Brigantes must have hoped the Romans would leave them alone.

Who were the Brigantes? - Intriguing History
In 51, the defeated resistance leader Caratacus sought sanctuary with the Brigantian queen, Cartimandua, but she showed her loyalty to the Romans by handing him over in chains. She and her husband Venutius are described as loyal and "defended by Roman arms", but they later divorced , Venutius taking up arms first against his ex-wife, then her Roman protectors.

Cartimandua continued to rule the Brigantes for a number of years with her own armour-bearer, Velloclatus, as her consort. However, the discontent was still growing in the ranks of the Brigantian rulers for another rebellion occurred during the governorship of Marcus Vettius Bolanus around 70AD.

Romans in Britain - The Brigantes Tribe

Cartimandua's husband, Venutius, leads a rebellion against her, probably as a ring-leader of the anti-Roman faction. The Romans

put down the rebellion, and Venutius and Cartimandua bury their differences and are reconciled. Venutius apparently retains his position as co-ruler until his wife replaces him in AD 69.

Kingdoms of British Celts - Brigantes
Cartimandua was queen of the Brigantes at that time and she agreed a 'client' relationship with Rome. Cartimandua remained in control of her lands and people, with Roman support when needed, and Brigantia provided a buffer zone between the settled south and the north. The Brigantians paid

taxes mainly in slaves, hunting dogs and horses.
